## WHO ARE THE YOUNG PROFESSIONALS?

Our young professionals have graduated from an Australian university with a Bachelor and/or Master in an ICT related field.

## HOW IS THE INTERNSHIP UNPAID?

Our young professionals are enrolled in ACS Professional Year Program for ICT - a work readiness program designed to help graduates boost their career opportunities. They are required to complete 32 weeks of Professional Development Training at NIT, followed by 10 to 12 weeks of unpaid ICT internship in Australia.

Completion of this program will support the graduates with attaining migration goals as specified by the Department of Home Affairs.
